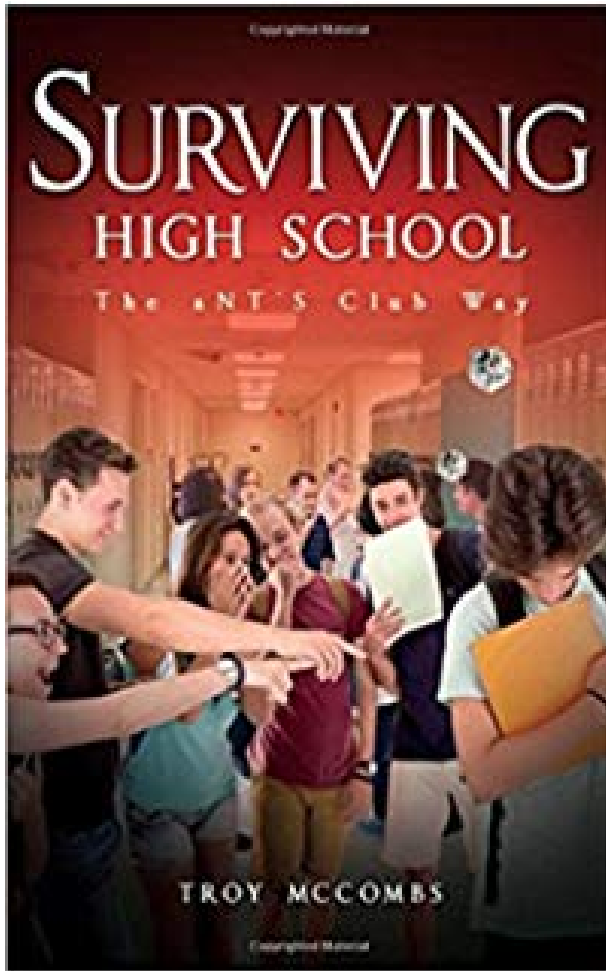


# Surviving High School (The aNT'S Club Way)
